Professional Compliance

Enhanced DBS certificate: Quality Teaching Staff requires an Enhanced DBS certificate through the Disclosure and Barring Service in order to seek work on your behalf.

Employment Agencies Act 1973: Quality Teaching Staff will provide you with work finding services in line with the requirements of the Employment Agencies Act 1973 and the Conduct Regulations 2003

Department for Education Compliances: As a qualified teacher working with Quality Teaching Staff Education it is important that you understand the following:

Qualified Teachers holding QTS: The records of all teachers holding QTS will be checked on the database maintained by the DfE's National College for Teaching and Leadership. This includes a check on Induction Status, Restrictions and Prohibitions.

Newly Qualified Teachers are required to abide by the requirements of Statutory Guidance for the Induction of NQTs (England): a qualified teacher who gained QTS on or after 1 September 2007 who has not completed an induction period, can undertake short-term supply work of less than one term in a relevant school for a maximum period of 5 years from the point of award of QTS.

Overseas Trained Teachers (OTTs): OTTs are required to obtain Qualified Teacher Status before 4 years have lapsed, following their first day of teaching in the UK.
